

Turkey Shoot on Nov 10

Time of event: 10:00 am to 2:00 pm

Shooter categories

Age ranges: Seniors – 55+ Junior shooters – less than 18 All others - 18 to 54

General guidelines

- Shooting rests – of the shooter’s choice; must be field expedient, e.g. rolled up coats, cross-sticks, bipods
- No ‘sight-in’ time allowed on the day of the event – one cold-bore shot allowed prior to competition
- Only three shots allowed (plus one cold bore) – that’s two more than a live turkey would give you in the field. Time limit of 3 minutes total time for ‘cold bore’ and 3 shots at turkey.
- Only shots closest to the eye AND in the head will count
- ‘Closest shots’ will be measured (w/ dial calipers) from center of the turkey eye to the center of the bullet hole.
- Only one turkey/certificate per family

100 yard shooting – scoped or open-sight rifles

- Center-fire rifles – any caliber
- 3 winners possible

50 yard shooting – open sights (no red dots)

- Center-fire rifles – any caliber
- 3 winners possible

25 yard shooting – any rimfire / scoped or open sights

- No bipods /cross-sticks allowed
- Junior shooters may use field expedient rests, e.g. coats, range bag, off a shooting bench
- “Seniors” and “all others” must fire standing (off-hand)
- 3 winners possible
